SCOPE OF POSITION

Chrysalis House is looking for a creative individual to develop a transition program for children and youth who are moving out of Chrysalis House. We are looking for someone who has a strong understanding of violence against women issues and the impact on children and youth. The contract is for approximately 60-70 hours and will require working closely with the Family Support Counsellor and Child and Youth Counsellor.

- Research and create a transition program for children and youth.
- Some of those hours will need to be coordinated with the Chrysalis House Child and Youth team.
- Deadline for completion is March 29th 2019, but earlier is better.
- Contract is open to casual, part time and full time staff
- Total hours worked for WOCRC each week cannot exceed 44; therefore you must schedule your hours accordingly.
- You will be asked to keep a log of the hours you put into the project and submit bi-weekly for payment.
